

Winter Mission Trip

'Wade in the water . . . God's a gonna trouble the water....' Are you ready for a life changing experience like none other??

If so, plan to join us for a Mission Trip to the Gulf Coast from Dec. 27th - Jan 1st. The trip is open to youth (grades 6 and up) **AND** adults! The cost is \$125 and will cover everything from the time we leave until the time we return. If money is the only thing preventing you from attending, please speak to Pastor Sonia, Fr. Steve, or Dcn. Pat.

- Dec. 27th - Depart from Christ the King at 8:15 a.m. traveling to Mississippi. The adults will stay at Camp Coast Care in Long Beach MS and the youth will stay at Mission on the Bay in Bay St. Louis MS. The two groups will be about 20 miles apart, but will get together for meals, worship, and fellowship. We may even find ourselves working side by side at some points during our trip.
- Dec. 28th & 29th - Work during the day, rest and play and worship in the evenings
- Dec. 30th - Worship in the morning, work some in the afternoon, rest & play in the evening
- Dec. 31st - Work during the day, pack up, play and worship in the evening
- Jan 1st - Depart from our base camps at 8:30 a.m. and arrive at Christ the King in the early evening

You do NOT need construction experience, but some kind of practical talent is very helpful – it can be painting, organizing paper work, cleaning, cooking, etc.

The Challenge - take who God has created you to be, with the beauty marks and the blemishes, and wade in the water – cause God is gonna trouble the water!
